
Foreword



STEM TIMELINE



The successful conclusion of Phase 4 of the STEM Leadership Training was marked by the STEM Symposium, a significant milestone in our commitment to advancing **STEM education in the Indian context**.

This initiative, a collaboration between the **Adani Foundation, the National Institute of Education (NIE), Singapore (part of Nanyang Technological University), and supported by Temasek Foundation**, showcased how students integrated real-world community challenges into their classrooms. By analyzing problems and proposing solutions, the learning experience became more student-led and connected to real-life issues.

The **STEM Symposium, held from February 17 to 19, 2025, was attended by 36 educators from seven Adani Schools**. These educators designed and presented their STEM-based CBSE curriculum lessons to a panel of six experts from NIE Singapore, further strengthening their pedagogical approach.

STEM for Bharat: Solving Problems in Classrooms

Seven schools presented exemplary lesson plans, evaluated by the expert team from NIE Singapore. These lessons demonstrated critical thinking, scientific inquiry, and real-world applications of STEM concepts, addressing local challenges from their communities. The top three schools were recognized for their outstanding contributions:

- **Champion:** Adani Public School, Mundra: Earthquake-Resistant Structure
- **1st Runner-up:** NRC School, Kalyan, Maharashtra – From Waste to Energy
- **2nd Runner-up:** Adani Vidya Mandir, Ahmedabad – Eco-Friendly Disposal of Stubble

This achievement highlights how STEM education empowers students to tackle real-world issues, transforming classrooms into hubs of innovation and problem-solving for a better Bharat.

This recognition reflects our heartfelt mission to provide quality education and opportunities for underprivileged children, paving the way for a better future.


Award Highlights:



NOURISHING DREAMS: THE NUTRITIOUS MEAL PROGRAM AT ACC MIDDLE SCHOOL, JHINKPANI






As an Adani School alumnus, I believe in the power of our community to create real change. Together, we have the strength to uplift, inspire, and make a lasting impact.
