Foreword

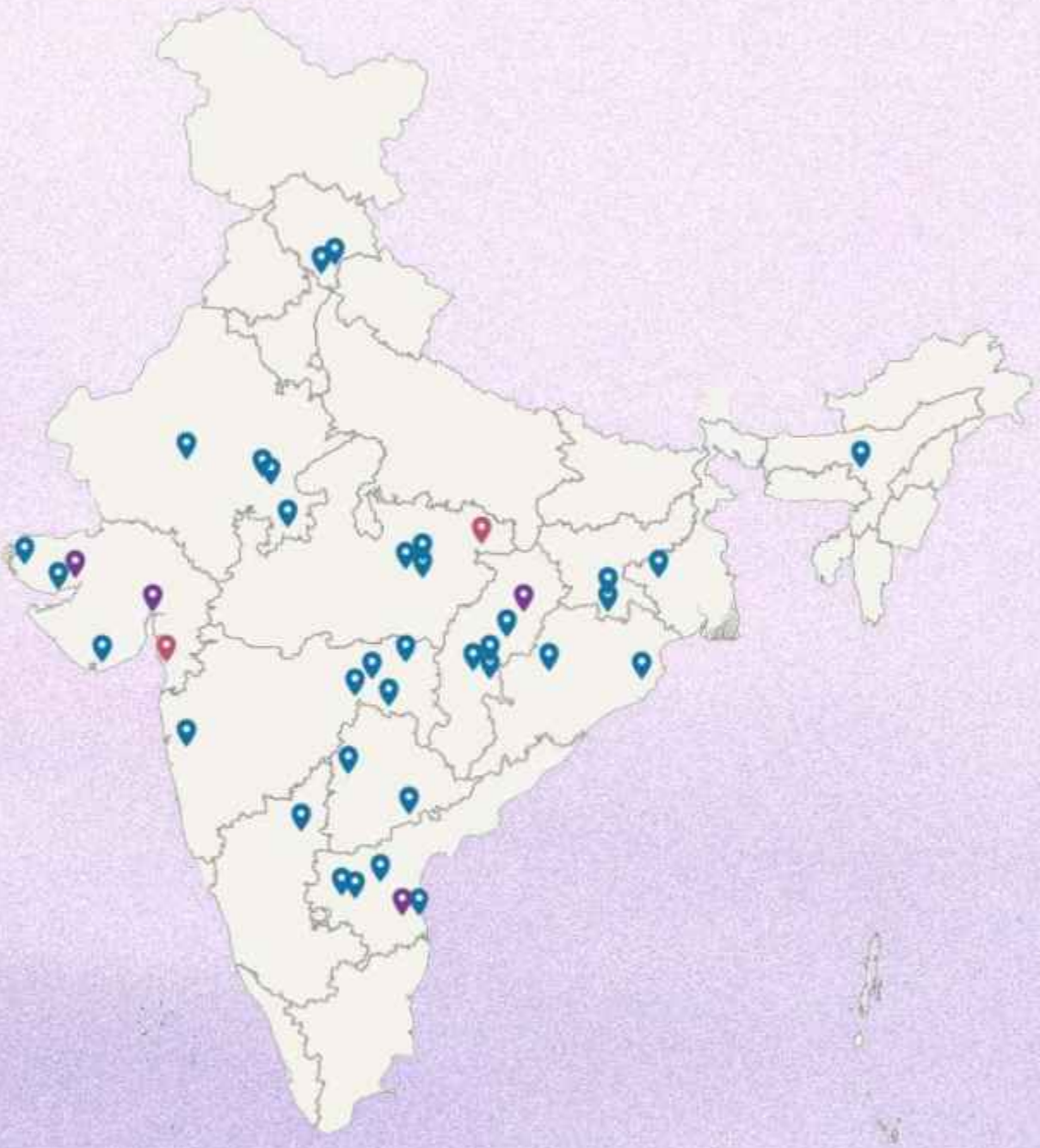

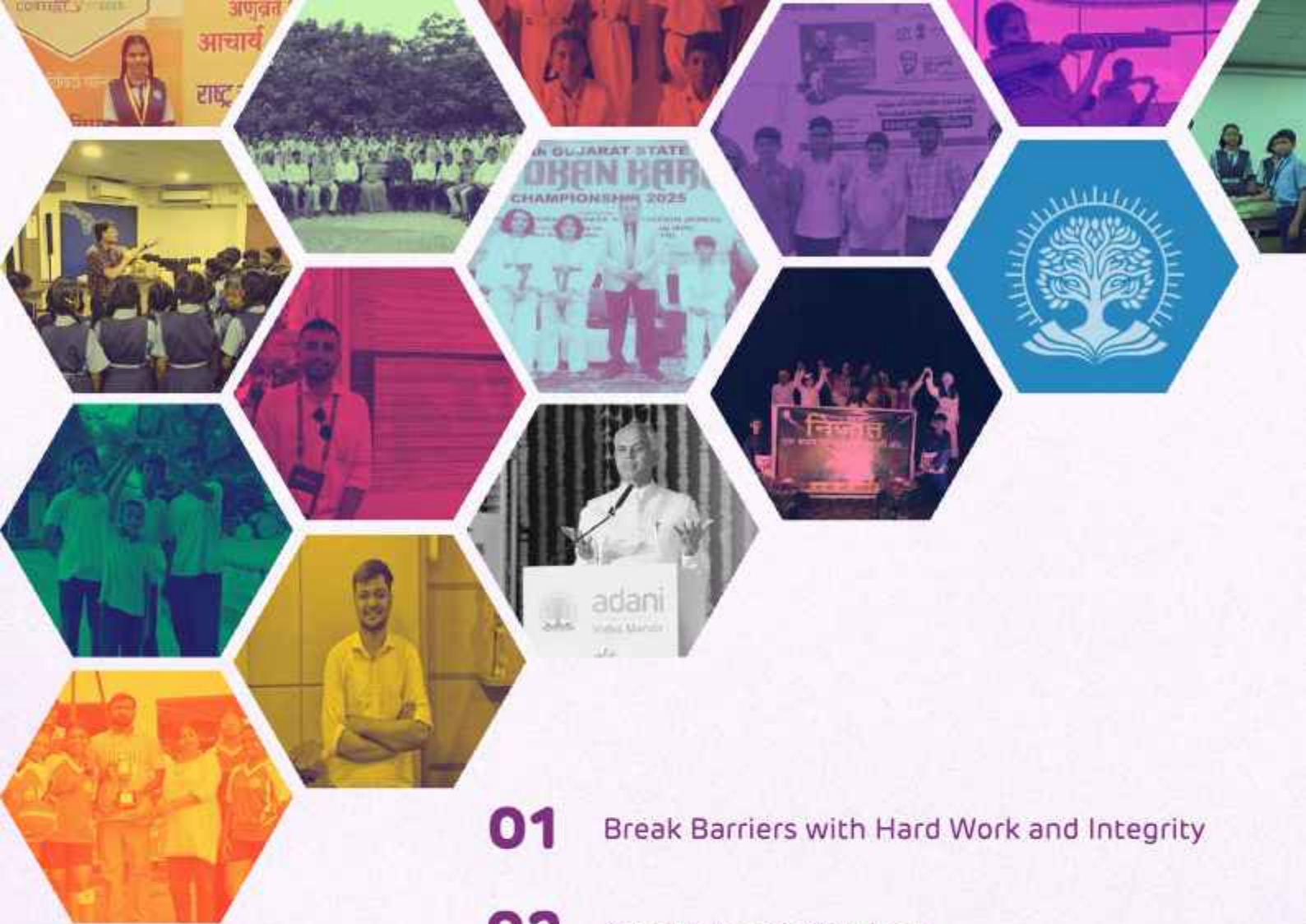

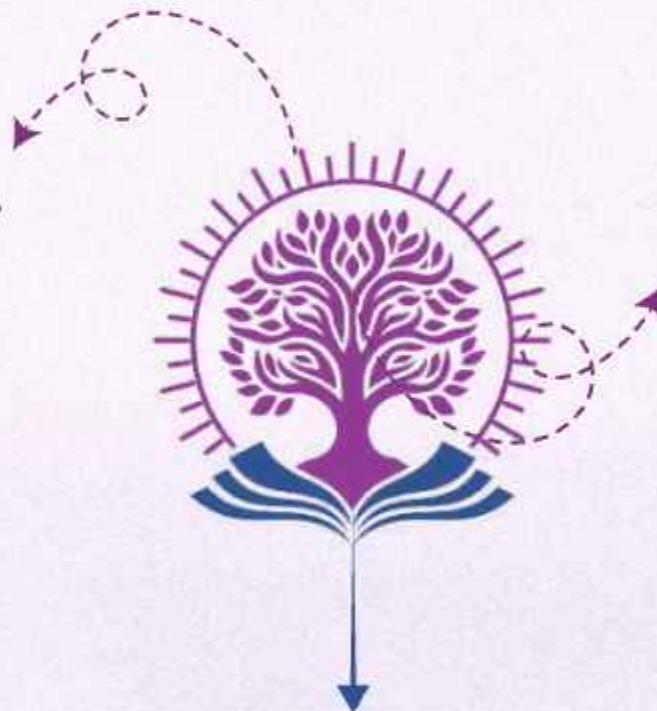

Teacher's Day 2025 – Adani Schools

Adani Schools celebrated Teacher's Day 2025 with reverence, joy, and unity. The day featured soulful prayers, heartfelt student tributes, alumni reflections, and a special video of joyful classrooms across the schools. Teachers too shared their voices, adding warmth and authenticity.

One of the highlight was the Thanksgiving Song, a powerful expression of gratitude that united all 43 Adani Schools into one culture of respect and belonging. It symbolized how every school, while unique in spirit, comes together as one Adani family rooted in learning and gratitude.

The celebration concluded with inspiring messages from Adani Foundation leaders and the National Anthem, a fitting tribute to the true architects of the future, our teachers.



STEM *for* Bharat



September marked strong progress under the **STEMforBharat** initiative, expanding STEM practices across Adani schools. A major milestone was the establishment of a **Centre of Excellence with 45 Master Trainers across 11 schools**. The STEM Curriculum 2025–26 is on track, moving from problem identification and lesson plan development to prototyping in October, a December symposium, and monologue publication.

The STEM Quartet Webinar (Sept 23–26) fostered collaborative learning, with October focusing on prototyping. Community outreach continues through STEM training in government schools and the upcoming Uthaan Schools program at Mundra (Oct 15). **AVNU trainers also led a successful hands-on session at Z.P. School, Upparwahi.**

Visibility has been enhanced via social media engagement and publications. **Lesson plans are being uploaded on the NIE website, alongside a research paper on STEM for Indian Schools.** Ahead, all schools - including ACC and DAV ACC - will join the STEM initiative, while book chapters for a Springer publication are nearing completion.

100% Success –

Penna College of Cement Sciences, Boyareddypalli



Students of **Penna College of Cement Sciences, Boyareddypalli, Andhra Pradesh (Managed by Adani Foundation)** achieved an extraordinary 100% pass rate in the II and IV semester examinations, far above the Sri Krishnadevaraya University averages of 45.55% and 54.50%.

What makes this achievement even more special is that many of these students come from modest academic and family backgrounds. Their determination, combined with strong mentoring, has shown how the right support can turn potential into achievement.

From Classrooms to Bookshelves



Students of **DAVACC Public School, Lakheri (managed by Adani Foundation)** have successfully written and published their very first books.

This initiative was launched to encourage and nurture writing skills, and it has brought wonderful results. Many of our students are now proud debut authors, with their books published by **BriBooks**.

Panav Mori (Class 7B) displayed excellent focus and strategic thinking to win 1st place at the **SGFI District Chess Tournament (Boys U-14)**. His calm composure under pressure made his victory remarkable.



Football Glory

Upper Primary School, Lakheri

Three talented footballers – Mohammad Islam Khan (Class VII), Aman Kumar (Class VIII), and Arhan Beg (Class VIII) – were selected to represent at the State-Level U-14 Football Tournament in Bhilwara, Rajasthan. Their teamwork and passion brought pride to the school.



Karate Achievements : AVN Kodinar

At the 15th Gujarat State Shotokan Karate Championship 2025:

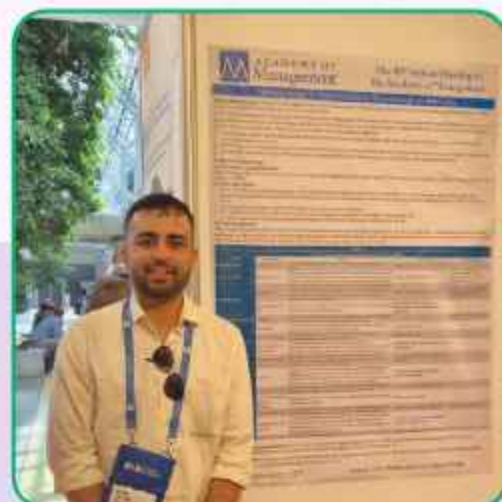

Nitin Sharma is currently pursuing his **PhD in Human Resource Management at the IIM-A**. He completed his schooling at DAV Barmana (2001–2010) (now managed by Adani Foundation) and graduated in Mechanical Engineering from NIT Hamirpur in 2014. He began his career with Hero MotoCorp, where alongside work, he prepared for competitive management exams. His growing passion for people management led him to XLRI Jamshedpur, where he earned an MBA in HRM. Following his post-graduation, Nitin joined IDFC First Bank as Manager, Talent Management and Culture, before transitioning to academia to pursue research.

Since his undergraduate days, Nitin has maintained a deep interest in research. His work has been presented at several leading national and international forums, including the Academy of Management (Chicago 2024, Copenhagen 2025), the EGOS Colloquium (Athens, 2025), IISc Bengaluru, and IIM Ahmedabad. His doctoral thesis investigates the intersection of technology and people management, with a particular focus on generative AI, algorithmic management, and their implications for the future of HR.

Beyond technology and management, Nitin's broader research interests lie in understanding how employees navigate career insecurity and how workplaces evolve with the entry of Gen Z and Gen Alpha into the workforce. His work aspires to bridge the gap between practice and scholarship, bringing fresh insights into the changing nature of work and organizations.

Project Utthan is dedicated to **enhancing foundational literacy and numeracy among students in government primary schools**, focusing on holistic school development and empowering Priya Vidyarthis (progressive learners). A dedicated Utthan Sahayak (supplementary teacher) is appointed in each school to act as a catalyst and facilitator of this transformation. Key elements of Utthan include making learning joyful, providing necessary resources and facilities, fostering literacy, numeracy and life skills and building teachers' capacities. Special emphasis is placed on nurturing Priya Vidyarthis and celebrating their progress. The initiative also strengthens government primary schools to make them a preferred choice for lower-middle-class families seeking quality education for their children.

Getting Set to Break the Barriers



Adani Foundation has launched Project Utthan across all BMC primary schools with the vision that no child is left behind, because when every child is empowered, the nation is strengthened. The project aspires to position **BMC schools** among the **top 15 districts of Maharashtra** by driving a focused transformation in Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN), fully aligned with NIPUN Bharat and NEP 2020.

In September 2025, Project Utthan organized an induction session in Mumbai for the newly selected Cluster Heads and Coordinators. This initiative prepared our team to step into the role of Master Trainers in FLN. From October 6–8, 2025, these trainers will mentor and equip over 1,000 BMC teachers of Classes 1 to 4, laying strong foundations in reading, writing, and mathematics for every child. With the right preparation and focused intervention, Project Utthan is emerging as a catalyst for transforming BMC schools into true temples of learning and growth.
